This year's event helps benefit She Has A Name, a strong community of abolitionists that exists to fight human trafficking through education, collaboration, and survivor care. As a community resource, their focus is on defining human trafficking, the needs of survivors, and getting connected. Unfortunately, Ohio ranks fourth in the country for human trafficking cases reported to the National Human Trafficking Hotline. In 2017 alone, they served over 310 survivors and they'll use the funds raised at the Annual Charity Fashion Show to strengthen resources provided to those impacted by human trafficking in our community. Any additional funds raised will benefit the NAWN Endowment Fund.

By defining human trafficking and focusing on education, they truly are making a huge difference in our community.
